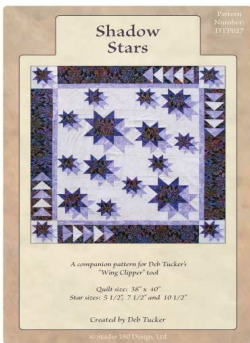


Technique Workshops (No Fee)

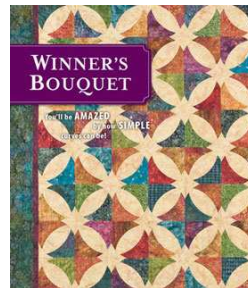

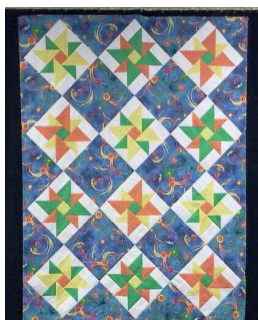
This versatile quilt will allow you to use your choice of traditional fabrics to bright fabrics. The star blocks are done using partial seam construction. Pattern purchase is required.

Candice Big

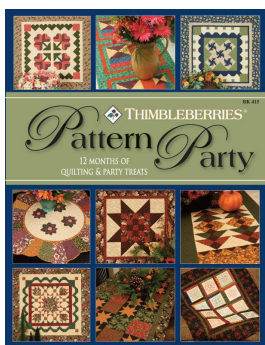

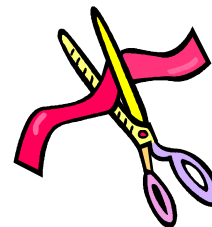
